



## Implementation of the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008 — Alert Number II

October 6, 2008

Pursuant to the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008 (EESA), the United States Department of the Treasury (Treasury) has just posted three Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for financial agents on its website at <http://www.treas.gov/press/releases/hp1185.htm>.

The three services being sought are:

- ▶ Custodian, Accounting, Auction Management, and Other Infrastructure Services
- ▶ Securities Asset Management Services
- ▶ Whole Loan Asset Management Services

Responses must be submitted on or before Wednesday, October 8, 2008 by 5 p.m. (EDT). According to Treasury, selection decisions will be made next week.
